5 Truths to hold on to when you don’t know where you are, or where your going:

1. **God is focused on you.** *You comprehend my path and my lying down, And are acquainted with all my ways. Psalms 139:3*
2. **God knows your words– but desires relationship.** *For there is not a word on my tongue, But behold, O LORD, You know it altogether. Psalms 139:4*
3. **You will never be outside of His reach or access.** *Where can I go from Your Spirit? Or where can I flee from Your presence? If I ascend into heaven, You are there; If I make my bed in hell, behold, You are there. If I take the wings of the morning, And dwell in the uttermost parts of the sea, Even there Your hand shall lead me, And Your right hand shall hold me. Psalms 139:7-10*
4. **When you are in the darkest trial of your life– He will turn the light on.** *If I say, “Surely the darkness shall fall on me,” Even the night shall be light about me; Indeed, the darkness shall not hide from You, But the night shines as the day; The darkness and the light are both alike to You. For You formed my inward parts; You covered me in my mother’s womb. Psalms 139:11-13*
5. **God thinks precious thoughts toward you daily.** *How precious also are Your thoughts to me, O God! How great is the sum of them! If I should count them, they would be more in number than the sand. Psalms 139:17-18*
